4. Report on Year 04/05

The Chairman reported that season 2004/5 had been one of the most successful yet for the Youth Section. A total of 14 teams represented the club throughout the season including our first ever girls teams. Treasurer offered a vote of thanks to Simon Murray, the accountant who had audited the Kingstonian Youth accounts.
