## **4. Chairman's Report on Year 05/06**

The Chair reported it had been a very successful year both on and off the pitch. The tremendous progress of Kingstonian Youth had been recognised by the FA with the award of Charter and Development Club Status. He thanked all Board members and those co-opted over the year for all their time and effort. In particular the Chair wanted to thank John Fenwick who was standing down from the Board for the tremendous contribution he had made as a founding Board member. His contribution as treasurer as been vital in the development of Kingstonian Youth FC.

## **5. Accounts**

The expansion of Kingstonian Youth from 14 to 20 teams had a significant impact on both income and expenditure, but the overall solvent financial position remained constant with a small excess of income over expenditure for the season.

This was achieved with a great deal of support from the fundraising team, who managed to raise over £5,000 from events held during the season. Donations, sponsorship and grants received also assisted in covering the increased expenditure on kit, equipment and training and match pitches.

Once again our grateful thanks are extended to Simon Murray, who provided an independent review of the final accounts. Chair formally proposed and accepted the accounts.
